**Agencies extend comment period on plan to
remove water from old INEEL spent fuel basins**

The U.S. Department of Energy, in cooperation with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Idaho Department of Environmental Quality, is asking for public comment on a proposal to remove 1.5 million gallons of water and sludge from INEEL 1950's-era spent nuclear fuel basins. The comment period has been extended to run through September 23.

An Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis document available at cleanup.inel.gov, describes the proposal to remove more than a million gallons of water from three basins at the Idaho Nuclear Technology and Engineering Center.

This document is also available in the INEEL Administrative Record file for Waste Area
