





Record of Decision Availability

The U.S. Department of Energy announces the availability of the Record of Decision for an Interim Action to Cleanup Unexploded Ordnance Locations at the Idaho National Engineering Laboratory

During the first week of June 1992, the U.S. Department of Energy, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare signed a Record of Decision selecting the cleanup remedy for unexploded ordnance at identified sites in Waste Area Group 10 at the Idaho National Engineering Laboratory. The Record of Decision outlines the agencies' decision on a cleanup remedy, and includes a "Responsiveness Summary" prepared by the agencies to address public comments received during the comment period.

Remedy

The Agencies have jointly decided that Alternative 3 - Detonation and Disposal Onsite. Off-site Incineration of Contaminated Soil, is the selected remedy. The major components of the remedy are:

- Record search of INEL ordnance locations.
- Placement of administrative barriers (signs).
 - Search and detonation of ordnance.

 - Sampling of soils suspected of contamination.
 Removal of contaminated soil for off-site incineration and disposal.
