



Comment Period Extended

on the Proposed Plan for the Power Burst Facility

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare announce the extension of the public comment period as a result of written comments received on the Proposed Plan for the corrosive waste sump and the evaporation pond at the Power Burst Facility. The original comment period was scheduled to end on April 24, 1992. The agencies have extended the comment period by 30 days in accordance with the National Contingency Plan contained in 40 CFR Part 300.430(f).
