IDAHO CHEMICAL PROCESSING PLANT TRANSITION PLAN MADE AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC

The Department of Energy Idaho Operations Office announced today that its draft Idaho Chemical Processing Plant Transition Plan is available to the public. When finalized, this plan will discuss the change in the ICPP mission and will provide the process by which ICPP reprocessing facilities will be transitioned.

The plan will be used to guide the contractor in the subsequent collection of physical characterization data and related evaluations from which determinations of future use or final disposition can be based. The plan also addresses the minor workforce restructuring and retraining within the ICPP which will be required as a result of the termination of reprocessing.

Copies of the draft plan have been placed in the DOE Public Reading at the INEL Technical Library in Idaho Falls; public libraries in Idaho Falls, Pocatello, Twin Falls, Boise and Fort Hall; the Idaho State Library in Boise; the University of Idaho Library in Moscow; and the INEL Outreach Offices in Pocatello, Twin Falls, Boise and Moscow.
