2. Site Title: STF-01 "STF-601 Sumps and Pits"

3. Describe the conditions that indicate a possible inactive or unreported waste site. Include location and description of suspicious condition, amount or extent of condition and date observed. A location map and/or diagram identifying the site against controlled survey points or global positioning system descriptors shall be included to help with the site visit. Include any known common names or location descriptors for the waste site.

Location: The Security Training Facility (formerly the Experimental Organic Cooler Reactor) building STF-601, which is near the main INEEL entrance a half-mile east on the road to PBF. The STF-601 building has been used intermittently since 1963 (when the EOCR project was canceled) for material storage, security force practice maneuvers, and occasional destructive testing of reactor components or hazardous materials.

Conditions: D&D discovered the flooded sumps and pits contain loose asbestos. Stained water-paths from the ceiling flow over crumbling asbestos plastered walls and pipes. High water marks on the walls are many feet higher than the present level.

Amount or extent: Approximately 200,000 gallons of water are currently in the basement. Unknown past volumes have dispersed from building mostly through floor drains, grates, and sumps.

The STF-601 building is scheduled to be D&D'd in FY99, funding permitting and the activities will be re-evaluated for potential threat of release.
