Dr. Hempelmann will check into Rochester files in some way today and tomorrow to find out whether there are any records from the early Atomic Energy Project under Manhattan project. He will also go through the LASL files. In contrast to what Pat Durbin said Hempelmann does not know whether Wright Langham worked in Chicago at all. He thinks that Wright went directly from Rochester to LASL. who is a manic depressive and may not be useful for information but is not to be overlooked retired from Rochester and is now in North Carolina.
