While reviewing the case file of , I noted that Dr. Jan Lieben's memo of November 28, 1973, listed an " as one of the second cousins. But no subsequent reference to as found. phoned Dr. Lieben who said that he did not recall why there was no follow-up of Mr. and suggested that we phone some of the relatives from Argonne.

April 25, 1978

I phoned Mrs. , (New York, area) and asked whether she knew of the whereabouts of , who is reported to be a second cousin. Mrs. was very positive in saying that she had never heard of an

I phoned . Since he was not in, I told Mrs. that I was trying to determine who is and where is . Mrs. said she never heard of him, that must be who is long dead, at least the she knew of is dead. Arranged for AFS to phone after 6:00 p.m.

By phone, confirmed that there was an now dead, who had two sisters in Rochester. He suggested that I call Mrs. one of the sisters. Mr. also informed me that his (father, died in 1974.

April 26, 1978

By phone, Mrs. confirmed that was her brother and that he died "four years ago."
