FAST: Current Status

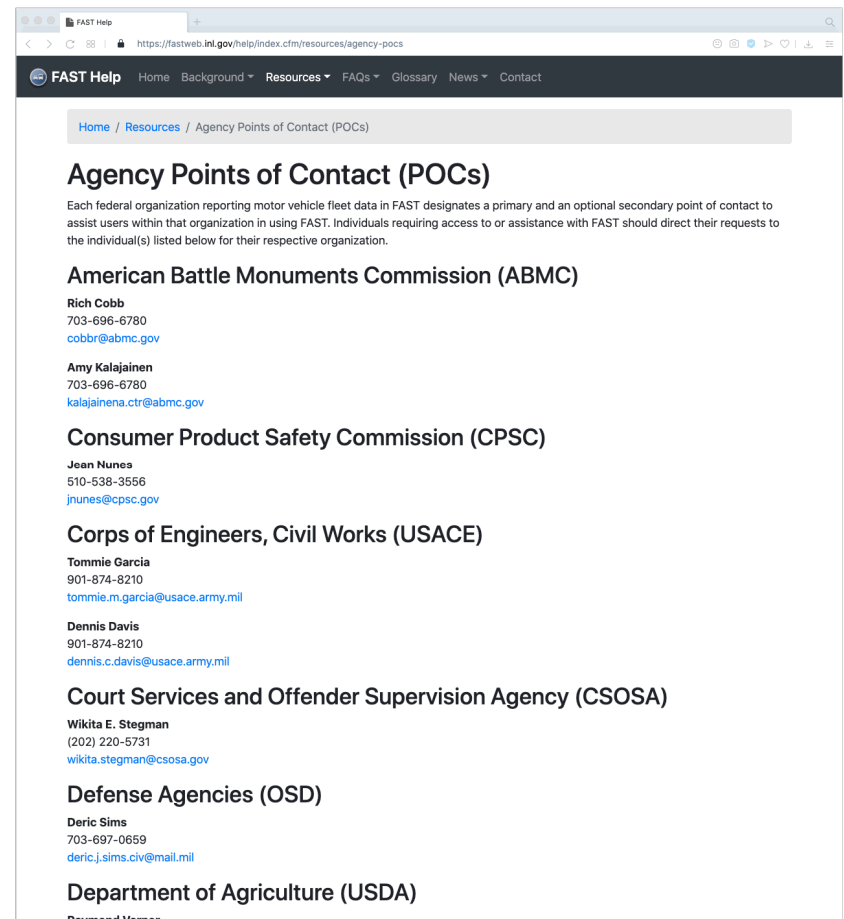
- **FAST returned to normal availability October 8**
- **FAST Sandbox returned to availability November 5**
- **Work during outage caused several tasks to be deferred**
 - Overhaul of VLD reference documents
 - VLD export
 - Query tool updates
- **Changes to user management from updated security policies**
 - User accounts inactivated after 150 days w/o access
 - ... retired after one year w/o access

FAST: Data Collection Activities

- **FY 2020 primary fleet data call**
 - Began October 8 with FAST's return to availability
 - Agencies to complete submissions by December 15
 - Similar review & feedback process as prior year
 - *Recommendation: review significant issues noted in FY 2019 cycle as part of preparing and reviewing your FY 2020 submission*
- **FY 2020 fueling center & EVSE inventory reporting**
 - Similar data, new process for submitting this year
 - Single submission covering both fueling centers and EVSE
 - Single submission per agency
 - Due November 16

FAST: Program Points of Contact

- **FAST users should always start with their designated agency POC(s)**
 - List of POCs is maintained by each agency
 - Available from FAST sign-in page and in FAST Help
